Note that this is for the version built after the Sequine, TX factory closed with N2552T as the final bird. The specs are the same. N2533T has a 330 HP engine versus the 285 spec'd. That's about 1/6 or 16% increase in power over the original so performance will improve dramatically, particularly short-field operations. -mrp 210427

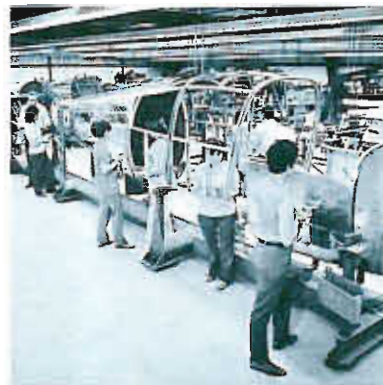
